<u>Years 1 - 6:</u> Dinner menus for the weeks commencing 15th, 22nd and 29th September 2025 are now available to view on the school website and orders can be placed online via SCOPAY. The deadline for placing orders is 1pm on Wednesday 10th September 2025.

EYFS: Paper copies of the dinner menus for the weeks commencing 15th, 22nd and 29th September 2025 have been sent home with Robins and Wrens children in their book bags today. If you would prefer to order online then this can be done from Monday 8th September when your child will be sent home with their Scopay account details. The deadline for placing orders (either by returning the paper copy to the school office or by ordering online via Scopay) is 1pm on Wednesday 10th September 2025.

All Years: A copy of the allergen list can be found on the school website. It is the responsibility of parents/carers to ensure that, where necessary, you have checked the allergen list and ordered an appropriate meal accordingly. This also applies to ensuring that any children with any other dietary requirements are also ordered the correct meal (i.e. vegetarians and those with religious beliefs). There will be no charge for those entitled to Universal Free School Meals (reception, Year 1 and Year 2) and to those children in other year groups entitled to means tested free school meals. The charge for all other children is £2.20, payment can be made online or by cash.
