Science Day - Thursday 21st March

Yesterday was our whole school Science day, entitled 'Spring into Science'. All classes completed the same experiments in the morning, using pipettes to see how many drops of water they could fit on a penny followed by an investigation involving jelly babies.

We loved having the chance to hear from and speak to some 'real scientists', our guest speakers included two science teachers from Maltings, who showed Year 5 and Year 6 some fascinating science which they will be doing in the coming years at secondary school, a radiographer, a computer scientist and a hospital laboratory worker.

In the afternoon, we did different activities involving Spring: looking for signs of spring, sketching spring flowers, painting the four seasons of a tree, investigating unusual life cycles and looking at the differences between the beaks of birds.
